Partner Spotlight: Hospitality Trainees Gain Real-life Skills for Financial Success



UNITE HERE Chicago
Hospitality Institute,
or UHCHI, is one of
Ladder Up's newer
partners. UHCHI is the
first US Department
of Labor-certified
apprenticeship program
that trains individuals
for employment in the
unionized hospitality
industry in Chicago.

UHCHI helps place their apprentice program "Completers" into unionized positions at area hotels, restaurants, and event venues, helping those businesses fill open positions. Employers say because UCHI completers are so well prepared, they spend less money and time on-boarding the new employees. Sounds like a win!

"However," warns UHCHI Executive Director Sheryl Morris, "while they may earn a higher hourly rate than before, many don't know how to make their money work for them." One of UHCHI's goals is to ensure that Completers do not become or remain "working poor" due to lack of personal finance skills.

This is where the partnership with Ladder Up comes in. Our FINCAP programming—covering Budgeting Basics, Credit Scores, and Understanding Employment Onboarding—helps prepare participants to enter the workforce on the right financial footing. Together, UHCHI and Ladder Up continue to improve the economic stability of many Chicagoans.

Morris hopes to expand what Ladder Up delivers to trainees, and says of the Ladder Up partnership, "It is a great fit – both of our organizations want to see people succeed."

Helping Make College Dreams a Reality



A college education is linked to higher pay, upward mobility, improved health outcomes, and greater civic involvement.
But funding college continues to be a barrier to many, especially Ladder Up

clients who are often first-generation students with neither the funds nor experience needed to make college dreams a reality.

The Ladder Up College Success Track program provides essential support to prospective and returning students to help make college financially feasible:

- General Information Sessions cover finding and applying for financial aid, including the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Alternative Application (for those without a Social Security Number).
- Financial Aid Completion Sessions coach students through the FAFSA or Alternative Application, helping students avoid missteps that may cause reduced or denied aid.
- Understanding Student Loans & Award
 Letters and Managing Your College Finances
 Workshops help students interpret the true cost of college attendance.

Our 2021 FAFSA applicants received over \$21M for college

"Ladder Up firmly believes that if a college education is the right next step," says Executive Director Phyllis Cavallone, "then we help our clients accomplish their goal with the least amount of debt possible."
