Who We Are

Ladder Up is a Chicago-based nonprofit that provides low-income, underserved communities with free financial services that help address many of the systemic inequities that can hold people back from realizing economic stability.



As Chicago's provider of free tax services, tax legal assistance, and financial education for low-income individuals, Ladder Up is a trusted alternative to predatory or scarce financial services in Illinois' most under-resourced communities.

What We Do

At Ladder Up, we give hardworking people the resources they need to move up the economic ladder, guiding them toward a brighter future through our Tax Assistance Program (TAP), Tax Clinic, and Financial Capability Program.

With over 29 years in operation, Ladder Up has returned over **\$1 billion** to the communities it serves.



Our Services

- Through our **Tax Assistance Program**, we help individuals
 and families prepare their taxes,
 securing the maximum allowed
 tax credits and refunds.
- Through our **Pro Bono Tax Clinic,** we help resolve tax issues and controversies, including stolen identity, audits, and tax debt issues.
- Through our **Financial Capabilities Program,** we deliver training in budgeting, savings, retirement, and investing, and provide instruction on obtaining financial aid for post-secondary education and training programs

2022-2023 Tax Season Impact

Our Tax Assistance Program provides free tax preparation and assistance to low-income clients across a dozen sites in Chicagoland. We provide this service primarily during the peak tax season, but also during the off season at select sites.

This past tax year, Ladder Up clients qualified for an average refund of \$1,428, and over 75% qualified for a federal tax refund. Tax refunds are often used to help with housing, medical expenses, groceries, and give these taxpayers a rare opportunity to save.

During the 2023 fiscal year, Ladder Up served over 27,000 individuals and their families with an economic impact of \$45.5 million dollars to the communities we serve.




Tax Clinic

Our Tax Clinic provides free assistance to clients with Federal and State tax problems, including stolen identity, audits, and tax debt issues. The Tax Clinic delivers nearly half a million dollars in decreased liabilities and rightfully returned refunds to our clients each year.

Our pro bono Tax Clinic held over 600 consultations, handled over 160 new cases, and was able to provide over \$610,000 in reduced tax liabilities or refunds to clients.

Financial Capabilities Program

Our Financial Capabilities Program delivers programming for households, students, and individuals to build financial skills and support sound financial decision-making. We reached nearly 5,000 individuals through our programming last year alone.

We serve nearly **20,000** clients with the greatest need from the city of Chicago and neighboring suburbs.



At our tax sites and legal clinic, we provide a wide-range of accommodations including wheelchair accessibility.



Our tax site volunteers speak over 115 languages, including American Sign Language, and help those with limited English proficiency.

Currently, we focus our work in underserved Chicago area communities where trustworthy financial services are scarce or predatory.




WHOM WE SERVE



Through this process and our observations, we estimate that **35-40**% of our population have limited English proficiency and/or unable to read or write in any language; **11**% have a disability, **51**% are women, **72.5**% are people of color, and almost **4**% are Native/Indigenous persons.

We meet the diversity and uniqueness of our Chicago clients by bilingual language support at all sites - including Spanish, Mandarin, Cantonese, Tagalog, Polish, Russian, Ukrainian, and American Sign Language.

As a nonprofit operated and led by women, we pride ourselves on being enlightened and inclusive. We each share a deep passion for the organization's mission. The full leadership team brings a multicultural, multi-generational perspective that includes immigrants, first-generation college graduates, and lived experiences in-tune with many of the challenges our clients face. The leadership team shares a specific passion for helping the underserved and immigrants, regardless of citizenship status.

Our Future

We know that nationwide, only 2% of those who qualify for free tax assistance are able to access this service. We want to change that. We intend to grow a minimum of 20% each year by opening additional physical in-person locations, expanding digital and virtual services, and improving overall organizational efficiency. Next year, we will be adding locations in Naperville and Waukegan.

Ladder Up is beginning to implement a three-year, multi-level strategic approach to expand our service model to include additional communities, including downstate and rural areas that have limited essential services, resources, and access to trustworthy financial services and support.

Our expansion plans will allow us to increase our presence to a total of **20** sites and serve **35,000** clients state-wide within three years.
